FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS AT FCBC

Making Arrangements

Notify the church on the passing of a family member or loved one. In addition to providing a venue for the celebration of your beloved, we are here to provide support and grief care.

If you seek to have a homegoing or memorial service here at FCBC:

We will discuss the appropriate date and time for your viewing and funeral service. It is preferred that funerals take place in the morning Monday, Wednesday and Thursday with an hour viewing to priced the homegoing service.

We will review what types of arrangements are need for the funeral such as choosing music selections, media support an officiant, and ushers.

The order of worship must be approved by an FCBC Pastor prior to printing. A template for FCBC approved services will be provided. Song selections are subject to change at the discretion of officiant.

FCBC MEMBERS

The bereaved family will not be charged for the usage of the sanctuary, one musician and an officiant. For additional musicians, media personnel, and sound technician family must cover all additional cost associated.

NON-MEMBERS

The bereaved family will be charged \$750 for the usage of the sanctuary for the funeral services. Additionally, the bereaved family must cover all applicable cost for the Minister (\$200), Musician (\$200), and Sound Engineer (\$200).

If the bereaved family is requesting use of FCBC for a repast, the Designee will inform the family that the maximum capacity of the FCBC fellowship hall cannot exceed **75 people**. The cost to host a repast in the fellowship hall is \$400 for non-members and \$200 for immediate family members of FCBC members which must be paid prior to the start of the repast. FCBC members are required to give a deposit of \$150, all of which will be returned at the end of the repast dependent upon the condition of the fellowship hall. All repasts must take place ONLY during the day. Evening repast are not allowed.

All Masonic, Eastern Star, Sorority/Fraternal organizational services must be pre- approved and cleared by an FCBC Pastor.
